## The Challenge

An intensely customer-focused business, ISS UK prides itself on delivering services that adapt fast to changing needs. IT operational responsiveness and agility are a primary requirement for an organisation that needs to interconnect with its core customers and partners and enable day-to-day business as usual services at almost 400 sites.

The UK network serves up connectivity to 20 regional offices and numerous customer facilities and supports a wide variety of services – everything from employee payroll to on-site office food and hospitality EPoS.

As one of the largest businesses in the group, the UK operation typically leads the way when it comes to initiating innovative new technology services. But dependency on the ISS group's primary IT platform meant implementing new initiatives and tools was a protracted and time-consuming process. Initiating new connectivity services for thousands of users – when a major contract came online, for example – could also take months to administer.

To respond quickly to customer demands, the UK IT team wanted to spin-up a dedicated UK data centre and network gateway to serve the needs of UK users. Alongside delivering the flexibility, the UK commercial operation require the new infrastructure platform to enable new web and mobility services to be initiated at speed.

To help make its vision of agile IT a reality, ISS UK wanted to work with a partner that could implement and secure its IT environment, enabling deep connectivity to the global group platform alongside UK-wide VPN services to both ISS-UK sites and multiple client locations.

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## The Solution

Tasked with overseeing the set-up of the new co-located Data Centre, ISN implemented the core network and fast IP connections that served the requirements of the UK business, along with the VPN services responsible for transporting data and services to customer sites. A secure gateway delivers the international breakout the UK business needs to connect to the global platform. The entire environment is protected by a next-generation network firewall, alongside highly adaptive security appliances, application controls, advanced malware protection and application control and intrusion protection.

“Connectivity and security are a priority and our customers depend upon us to operate at the very highest levels when it comes to enabling them to address compliance responsibilities. To this end, we now depend on ISN to monitor and manage the entire environment, ensuring that it’s optimised and aligned to our strategic business and commercial needs,” continues Graham.

The initial Data Centre implementation project was completed in just five weeks – making it possible for ISS UK to unify its resources and take control of the rapid provisioning of new services at a pace that meets the needs of customers.

“Today we can make immediate changes, test these and then make services live – in impressive short timeframes,” says Graham. “We now have a dependable high-performance connectivity platform that’s highly extensible and allows us to move at speed.”
